"The Connections Between Periodontal Health and Systemic Well-Being:

What Do They Mean to My Practice?"

Course Description:

Many patients come into dental offices today with questions about the "Mouth-Body Connection". They're reading about these relationships in *Reader's Digest*, *Redbook*, and *Good Housekeeping*, as well as on the Internet. Referring dentists also have questions about these relationships. What are the facts? What does the evidence tell us about the relationships between inflammatory oral diseases and systemic health? This lecture is designed to review the interrelationships between oral health and systemic conditions such as immune compromise, osteoporosis, cardiovascular diseases, diabetes mellitus, and pregnancy. The goal of the lecture is to have a clinically relevant discussion of our current knowledge in this area, founded on evidence but rooted in daily practice.

About Dr. Mealey:

Dr. Brian Mealey is a Professor in the Department of Periodontics at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, where he runs the Graduate Periodontics Program. He is also an Adjunct Associate Professor of Periodontics at Baylor College of Dentistry, Texas A&M University Health System in Dallas, Texas. He served 21 years in the United States Air Force, where he was the Chair of the Department of Periodontics at Wilford Hall Medical Center in San Antonio and the Program Director of the Air Force Periodontics Residency. Dr. Mealey is a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology, and is currently a Director of the Board. He has published over 80 articles, abstracts and textbook chapters in the scientific literature, with an emphasis on inter-relationships between oral and systemic health. He is co-editor and author of the textbook Periodontics: Medicine, Surgery and Dental Implants, published in 2004 and the textbook Periodontal Medicine, published in 2000.
