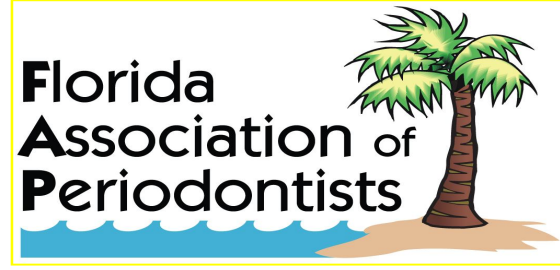

Saturday, February 20, 2010

About Dr. McGuire: Dr. McGuire is a graduate from Baylor University and received both his DDS and Certificate of Periodontics from Emory University School of Dentistry. He maintains a full-time private practice limited to periodontics in Houston, Texas and is a Clinical Assistant Professor of Periodontics at the University of Texas Dental Branch at Houston and the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology and is past president of the American Academy of Periodontology. Dr. McGuire's research has received the highest recognition of excellence, receiving both the Robinson Regeneration Award and the Clinical Research Award. Dr. McGuire is a recipient of the AAP's prestigious Master Clinician Award.

"Reaching Your Periodontal Potential through Restorative Dentistry. Biologic Shaping an Alternative to Conventional Crown Lengthening"

This course offers three hours of continuing education.

Course Description: The main theme of the presentation will be to emphasize the TEAM approach to treating comprehensive periodontal and restorative cases. The importance of cores and provisionals in periodontal surgery will be discussed as well the significance of connective tissue. Biologic Shaping will be presented as an alternative to conventional crown lengthening as well as its importance to long term maintenance of periodontal-restorative cases.

About Dr. Melker: Dr. Melker attended the University of Florida, Emory University and the Boston University School of Dentistry. He is in private practice (Periodontics) in Clearwater, Florida. Dr. Melker lectures to the University of Florida Periodontic and Prosthodontic graduate programs, as well at other many other graduate programs throughout the United States. He has presented at many professional dental associations, including the Massachusetts Dental Association and the New Orleans Dental Congress.
